

VISUAL ARTS



Something exciting is happening here in Darke County, but many people are not aware of this development. Did you know that Darke County Center for the Arts is spearheading creation of an Arts Trail, and the first new installation will occur later this year with a statue of revered Indian leader Tecumseh placed on Darke County Park District ground at or near the very spot where he and his brother lived in the first decade of the nineteenth century?! Union City artist Joshua Shepherd created this work, which will be unveiled as part of the celebration introducing the Art Trail. This is happening in coordination with the 50th anniversary of the creation of Darke County Parks! Lovers of the arts, nature, and/or history should be thrilled about this momentous convergence.

The Tecumseh Statue marks just one stop on the Darke County Public Art Trail. Additional stops will be marked throughout the county and will include artworks such as murals, statues, and barn art.

DCCA Facts



Darke County Center for the Arts is a not-for-profit organization formed in 1978 by a visionary group of five local citizens desiring to expand cultural enrichment in the community by supporting all of the arts. They were also committed to the restoration and preservation of Henry St. Clair Memorial Hall.

DCCA has presented an Artists Series featuring outstanding performing artists for over 40 years. The Family Theatre Series was inaugurated in 1997, and in cooperation with Greenville City and Darke County schools, Arts In Education was added to the programming schedule in 1983.

In 2002, DCCA presented its first Missoula Children's Theatre summer residency, offering local students the opportunity to actively participate in the performing arts. The Coffee House series was introduced in 2006, allowing smaller, intimate performances in local venues.

DCCA's office is located on the third floor of the Greenville Public Library at 520 Sycamore Street, Greenville, Ohio.

The Anna Bier Art Gallery in St. Clair Memorial Hall displays visual art exhibits during DCCA Artists Series, Special Event performances and most Sundays from 12-2pm.

- St. Clair Memorial Hall address: 215 W. Fourth Street, Greenville, OH.

- The box office at St. Clair Memorial Hall opens one hour prior to performances. We encourage advance ticket purchases.

- Tickets are non-refundable. If you are unable to attend and cannot give the tickets to a friend, please call DCCA to donate your tickets for resale. You help fill the house and will receive a letter for tax credit.
- Patrons with special needs are important to us. Wheelchair seating is available at all Memorial Hall events. Accessible parking and entrance is located on the West side of the Hall. Parking lot entry is available from Central Avenue and Armstrong.
- Although the main floor is accessible by elevator, the balcony is not. Please inquire at the box office for main floor seating if stairs are an issue.
- Sign interpretation is available upon request, with two weeks advance notice required. Wireless hearing assistance is available at the box office.
- Ticket purchase is required for children age two and up.
- We offer group discounts! Give us a call for more information.
- Due to contractual obligation with our artists, performances are not cancelled unless a Level 3 weather emergency is declared in Darke County or other extenuating circumstances occur.
