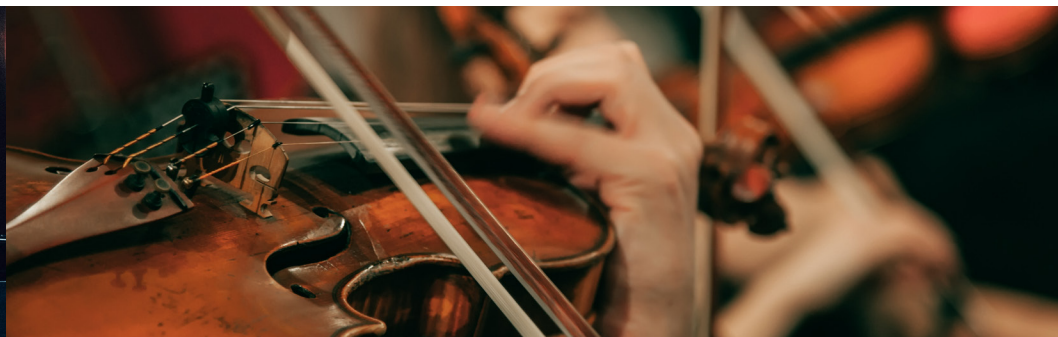


Broadway in Love

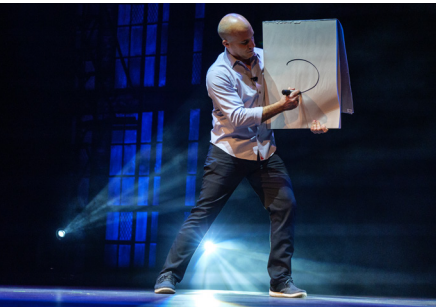

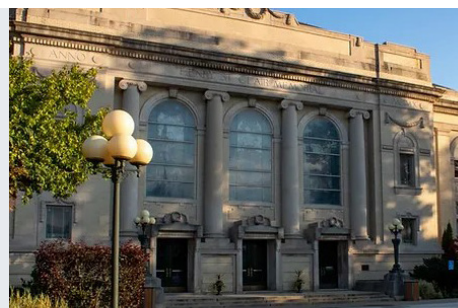

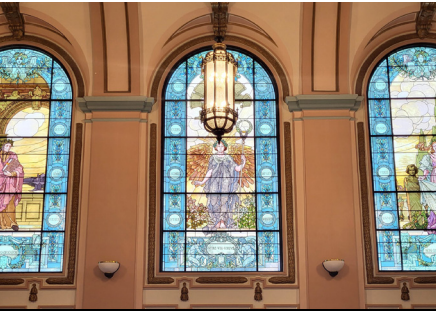


Missoula Children's Theatre

HIDDEN GEM

ST. CLAIR MEMORIAL HALL

Henry St. Clair ran a successful grocery business in the early 1900s. When he died in 1908, he bequeathed \$100,000 to the Greenville School Board to construct a building beneficial to the public. Overseen by his wife Ella, construction began in 1910 and included a marble lobby, three massive stained glass windows, and a Molar three-manual pipe organ from Maryland. The building is constructed of stone and gray pressed bricks. The entire lobby, stairs, column bases, door casings, and caps are made of polished Vermont marble.

POLICIES

The box office at St. Clair Memorial Hall opens one hour prior to each event. The auditorium opens 30 minutes before the show. Advanced ticket sales are encouraged. Tickets are non-refundable. If you are unable to attend a show, consider giving your ticket to a friend or donating it back for tax credit. Wheelchair seating is available and an accessible parking and entrance area is located on the West side of the hall. The main floor of the building is accessible by elevator, however the balcony is not. Please let the box office know if stairs are an issue. Ticket purchase is required for kids aged two and up. Due to contractual obligations to artists, shows are not cancelled unless there is a level 3 snow emergency in Darke County. Call DCCA at 937-547-0908 for more info.
